

Check List to Bring:

1. Sewing Machine
 - a. power cord
 - b. foot control
 - c. presser feet
 - d. single hole needle plate if needed
 - e. zigzag plate if needed
2. Sewing machine needles
3. Bobbins
4. Straight pins
5. Thread for projects: quilt construction, quilting, clothing, etc
6. Fabric scissors
7. Thread scissors or snips
8. Rotary cutter
9. Rotary rulers
10. Mat for personal use or use those at the cutting stations
11. Fabric marking pencils
12. Fabric for project #1
13. Pattern for project
14. Templates for project
15. Fabric for project #2
16. Do you also need>>>
 - a. Free motion presser foot
 - b. Machine extension table
 - c. Backing

17. Headphones for personal music or tablet
18. Phone or tablet charger
19. Reading/sewing glasses
20. Medication
21. Shawl or sweater for walking between buildings

Things Not Necessarily Needed:

1. **Ott lights** – Feel free to bring a lamp. However, unless you are working on dark fabric or have vision problems, you may not need an Ott light. I will be bringing 4 small Ott task lamps for general use and 2 LED task lamps.
2. **Portable irons** – Please do not bring a personal iron unless it is VERY low wattage, 250watts or less. Higher wattage can damage the sewing machines on the same circuit. There are three ironing boards in each sewing room and I can get more. Getting up and moving to the ironing boards can be a good thing!
