fabric requirements:

tote requires 2 1/2 - 3 yds fabric (44" wide) (Fabric amounts need to be adjusted for fussy cutting). Example yardage for 3 contrasting fabrics:

contrast 1 (C1)- 3/4 yd of darker print

contrast 2 (C2)- 1 1/2 yds of lighter print

contrast 3 (C3)- 3/4 yd of lighter or darker print

Interfacing requirements:

3 yds heavy weight fusible interfacing (20" wide)(Heat-n-Bond non-woven extra firm #Q2434 or Pellon #809 Décor Bond)

1 1/3 yds medium weight fusible interfacing (20" wide)(Heat-n-Bond or Pellon medium weight fusible)

1 1/4 yds paper backed double sided fusible interfacing (17" wide)(Pellon Wonder-Under #805)

hardware required:

1 x 22" separating zipper or YKK zipper with extra-long pull (nylon coil 4.5)

1 x 8" #3 coil zipper

1-1.5" swivel clip; 3/8" internal diameter (included with pattern purchase-instructor will bring to class)

Optional:

Fons and Porter Mechanical Chalk pencil
